Farmworker advocates have called for immediate action from the North Carolina Growers Association and NC Department of Labor, following the tragic passing of Jose Arturo Gonzalez, who is believed to have died due to heat-related illness. To highlight and address workers' rights issues, the Farmworker Advocacy Network organized a vigil and rally in Raleigh on November 3. NC FIELD, which is deeply involved in advocating for these rights, expressed heartfelt gratitude to the Farmworker Advocacy Network for hosting the "Ni Una Vida Más" Farmworker Vigil & Press Conference. Yesenia Cuello, the Executive Director, received specific commendation for her exceptional leadership and pivotal role as MC.



FARM AND FOOD WORKERS RELIEF PROGRAM (FFWR)

Our NC FIELD team remains dedicated to processing applications for the Farm and Food Worker Relief (FFWR Program, ensuring support for all qualifying agricultural workers. We are steadily progressing toward our goal of processing 4,000 applications and plan to handle an additional 4,000 in 2024. In November, we successfully processed 242 applications, distributing a total of \$145,200 for the month to aid farmworkers. Our commitment to providing crucial assistance to the agricultural workforce, who tirelessly ensured our sustenance throughout the pandemic, remains a top priority. Angel and his team have seamlessly shifted their focus to the seasonal agricultural workforce as planned and are preparing to resume accepting H2A migrant worker applications in early spring 2024.


