


Monthly Food Distribution Addressing food insecurity

Due to the increase in food scarcity, NC FIELD began doing monthly food distribution events in November 2021. We were able to provide ethnically appropriate foods to low resource residents in rural Duplin, Wayne, Sampson, Lenoir, and beyond.

In August 2022 we became a formal partner of the Foodbank for Central and Eastern North Carolina. In March we were able to provide food for 1930 people. To date more than 20,000 men, women, and children have receive(d) supplemental food supplies between October and May in 2022 & 2023
